Fall Sports Results

The Fall Sports season was again one of great achievement for Fox Chapel Area Teams. Nine out of ten fall sports posted winning records, eight teams qualified for the WPIAL playoffs, and four teams captured section championship titles.

The field hockey team won the section title with a record of 12-5-3 and defeated Pine Richland in the WPIAL playoffs. The team fell to North Allegheny in the WPIAL Championship, finishing the season as WPIAL runner-up.

The girls golf team raced through the regular season with an undefeated record of 13-0 earning the section title. The team then captured third place at the WPIAL championship.

Also finishing the regular season undefeated was the girls cross country team (10-0). The team captured their second consecutive section title and

finished fifth at the WPIAL championships.

The final section championship of the fall was captured by the girls volleyball team. The team's 10-4 overall record earned them a spot in the WPIAL playoffs again this season.

WPIAL playoff spots were also earned by the boys cross country team (8-2 section record), the boys golf team (9-3), the girls tennis team (12-2) and the boys soccer team (8-1-3).

Overall our fall sports compiled an overall record of 100-37-11 in head to head competition and a section record of 65-21-8.

Congratulations to all the fall athletes and coaches who represented Fox Chapel Area this year.

WPIAL & PIAA Medal Winners

Senior Rachel Humphrey led the girls cross country team to a fifth place finish at the WPIAL finals while finishing sixth individually and qualifying for the PIAA finals. At the PIAA Championships Rachel earned a medal by placing 18th in the state. Joining Rachel on the medal stand at the WPIAL meet was freshman Miranda Chang who finished 25th and also qualified for the PIAA Championship. From the boys team sophomore Connor Weis qualified for the PIAAs by placing 25th at the WPIAL event.

On the links the girls golf team advanced three individuals to WPIAL

finals. Senior Jodi Chesko, sophomore Molly Ford and freshman Nadia Luttner represented Fox Chapel at the event. Nadia carded a 77 to earn second place and advance to the PIAA tournament. At Tom's Run Golf Course in the PIAA Western Region Finals, Nadia shot one over par 73 to earn medalist honors. Nadia finished her season shooting a two round total of three over par to earn second place at the PIAA Championships.

Fuhrer – Hall of Fame Scholarship

Beginning in January applications for the Fuhrer Family Scholarship will be available in the High School Guidance Office. The scholarship is awarded to a Fox Chapel Area athlete who has demonstrated athletic and academic achievement along with financial need. The athlete chosen will be awarded 2,500 dollars a year, renewable for four years based on academic merit. Applicants need not plan participating in college athletics to be eligible.
