- Craig Mauro '96. Three year starter baseball and soccer, two year starter basketball. All section baseball, All WPIAL soccer. Three year starter at Cornell, two-time All Ivy Second Team. Three time All Ivy Academic Honors.
- Donna (Maiello) Morosky '69. Four varsity letters swimming. Two time team MVP and team captain. Earned top six finishes at PIAA Championships in three events. Four varsity letters at Slippery Rock, team captain and MVP. Men's and Women's swimming and diving coach at CMU '75-'90.
- David Ostrosky '89. Three year letter winner basketball. Three time All North and All Section. Post Gazette Fabulous Five. Leading scorer in Fox Chapel Boys' Basketball history. Four varsity letters and '92-'93 captain at Vermont.
- Ray Tarasi '86. Two time letter winner in football & soccer, four varsity letters in tennis. All Conference and Valley News All Star football. Penn State University - three varsity letters. Member of 1986 National Champions. Holiday Bowl Record 51 yard FG.
- Susie (Nettlebeck) Watkins '95. Four varsity letters in soccer. Three time All Section and All North.

Two time north Player of the Year. All State and Regional All-American '93, National All-American '94. Starter and letter winner at Wake Forest.

- Ron "Bumpy" Powell '58 Sharpsburg. Four year starter in football, two year starter in basketball. 2nd in scoring in WPIAL 1958. Big 33 participant. Varsity starter at Virginia Union.
- Chuck Lodge '48 Aspinwall. Two letters in baseball and football. Post Gazette and Sun Telegram All Star. Edinboro University four year starter football, letter winner track. Named to Edinboro "All Time Team". Member of Edinboro and Aspinwall Sports Hall of Fame.
- Harry Jenkins Basketball Coach. Varsity head coach for 25 years. 327 career victories. Fourteen WPIAL Playoff appearances, two time WPIAL finalist. Five PIAA playoff appearances. Two section championships. Four time Valley News Dispatch/ Post Gazette North "Coach of the Year."
- 1940-41 Sharpsburg Boys' Basketball. WPIAL Class B Champions. Only WPIAL Champion in Sharpsburg High School history. Defeated Bentleyville 41-39 in overtime for WPIAL victory.

SWIMMERS MAKE A SPLASH

The Fox Chapel Area Boys and Girls Swim Teams made a splash during the '07-'08 season. The team qualified 19 swimmers in total of 61 events for this year's WPIAL Championships. At the championship the girls finished fifth and the boys ninth.

Senior Meredith Hanley became the first Fox Chapel athlete in many years to qualify for the championships in both swimming and diving. She teamed with juniors Carol Lin, Jocelyn Bilkey and Maggie Deiseroth to finish second in the 200 freestyle relay at WPIALs. The 400

freestyle relay team of Lin, Bilkey, Deiseroth and Hailey Farrell finished third in the WPIALs. Individually, Carol Lin placed second in the 200IM and fifth in the 100 butterfly while freshman Hailey Farrell placed seventh in the 200IM and third in the 500 freestyle.

At PIAAs the 200 freestyle relay took thirteenth and the 400 relay finished sixteenth. Carol Lin finished with two strong finishes, ninth in the 200IM and fifteenth in the 100 fly.

On the boys side the 200 medley relay team of Brendan Walsh, Pat O'Toole, Alex Sunderman and Stephen Mohn finished seventh at WPIALs. In the 500 free Paul Weinstein captured sixth and Pat O'Toole placed seventh qualifying both for the PIAA meet. O'Toole also placed fifth in the 200IM while Walsh notched a fifth in the 100 backstroke.

WRESTLING AND GIRLS BASKETBALL EARN PLAYOFF BERTHS

The wrestling and girls basketball teams posted impressive seasons this winter.

The wrestling team completed its dual meet season with a record of seventeen wins and six losses qualifying once again for the WPIAL team championships. The team fell in round one to eventual WPIAL champion Connellsville.

Individually the Foxes posted impressive results at the section tournament qualifying ten wrestlers to the WPIAL and PIAA Regional Championships the most in school history. Carson Brooks (112) earned a section title while Joe Johnson (125), Justin Mahon (152), Nick Letters (160), Aaron Barker (171) and Dean

Smith (189) finished in second place at the section tournament.

The girls' basketball team posted an overall record of seventeen wins and eight losses and a section record of ten wins and two losses. The girls' finished the regular season impressively winning their final six section contests to capture a share of the section title while avenging earlier losses to Woodland Hills and Oakland Catholic.

The girls' season ended with a loss to Peters Township in the opening round of the WPIAL playoffs.

Congratulations to all of our winter athletes and their coaches on great seasons.
